The charity wants to develop the «Job' services» initiative. The aim is to set up workshops run by students for senior citizens in nursing homes. The added value of this project is that the students will be paid for their activities, thus helping them to bear the costs of student life. A project linking the well-being of seniors and the intergenerational link.
